- Manages the IS-BAO Program






Developed by the Industry for the Industry

a high level of safety and professionalism.


ICAO encourages participation in these programmes and is working to facilitate the exchange of aggregated information from these valuable sources of to help identify and address any systemic safety risks.

- Promotes Harmony of Operating Practices
- Scalable Fits all Sizes, Missions, Aircraft
- SMS is the Foundation
- Aligned with ICAO Annex 6 Part II / III
 - Plus best practices

Third Party Audit Required for IS-BAO Registration


- Conducted by IBAC accredited auditors
- List of Auditors on IS-BAO website
- Registration Validates:
 - Conformity with IS-BAO
 - Conformity with EASA Part NCC
 - Via IS-BAO Standard 3.3
 - Using IBAC Part NCC Compliance Tool





Align with International Standards AND Part NCC

- Part NCC is aligned with ICAO
- IS-BAO is aligned with ICAO
- IS-BAO and Part NCC are congruent
- IS-BAO validates alignment to both






EASA Part NCC GCOM & Compliance Tool

3.3 Compliance Monitoring

Each aircraft operator must establish and maintain a system for identifying applicable regulations, standards, approvals and exemptions and demonstrating compliance with them.
